## **LYNCHBURG COLLEGE ALUMNI CHOIR**

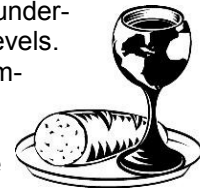

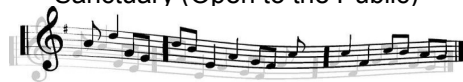
